In the Comments* box you can key in your objections - try keeping to planning issues such as the traffic, and stack emissions, impacts on the environment, impacts on the local tourist economy, impacts on the visual effects on the landscape etc.etc. (basically it's most things excluding house prices!!). Before submitting it is advised you copy your comments into a word document to keep them safe (see below)

If you want to add a document rather than write a comment you will see an **"Add a document"** button, (Permitted file types: pdf, jpg, jpeg, png, gif, txt and no bigger than 5mb in size), which will enable you to add a ready prepared document from your computer - just make sure the document you are adding has the planning application number, together with your name and address, otherwise it will not be counted.

When you have finished your comments, or uploaded your file, or both, then click the **"Submit"** button. If you do not receive a confirmation email within a few minutes of your submission acknowledging receipt of your submission, you will need to resubmit your saved comments. If you think of a different topic to write an objection on, then you can do it all again, as you are allowed to comment multi times as long as the topic is different. Good luck!!
